

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
"Crackerjack"	Marigold	Fruit Tree \$6.00	An easy to grow plant with massive double blooms in many shades of yellow and orange. Height to 90cm. Full sun. Deters beetles - much used in companion planting. Flowers are edible.
"Pandora" Passionfruit	Passiflora edulis	Fruit Tree \$3.50	Vigorous, heavy cropping tropical vine, bearing large sweet red-skinned fruit with excellent flavour. Self pollinating. Best in full sun. Seed grown.
Abiu	Pouteria caimito	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Tropical fruit tree bearing yellow skinned fruit with creamy translucent flesh of a sweet caramel custard flavour. Highly desirable due to it's superior taste.
Aloe barbadensis	Aloe Vera	Fruit Tree \$5.50	Small succulent plant whose anti-inflammatory sap is very useful for treating burns and dry, itchy skin. Can be used as a face mask by applying the gel, leaving 5-10mins, then washing off. Easy to grow in full sun or semi-shade.
Annona muricata	Soursop	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Tropical fruit similar to custard apple, but more acidic. Native to the Americas. A single fruit can weigh up to 6.8kg. Small evergreen tree to 4m tall.
Arkin	Carambola "Arkin"	Fruit Tree \$40.00	Also known as "Star Fruit". "Arkin" is a medium sized tree bearing heavy crops of sweet, juicy fruit with few seeds. Pick fruit after it turns yellow on the tree. Grafted.
Artocarpus heterophyllus	Jackfruit Jackfruit	Fruit Tree \$20.00	A tropical fruit tree best suited to moist areas. Ripe jackfruit tastes like a combination of banana and pineapple. The fruit can weigh up to 40kg, but are usually between 5 - 10kg.
Avocado	Hass	Fruit Tree \$45.00	Popular variety due to its superior taste and excellent keeping qualities. Medium sized pear-shaped fruit, excellent creamy nut flavoured flesh, no fibre. Mid to late season.
Avocado	Sharwill	Fruit Tree \$50.00	A medium sized fruit with rough green skin. The fruit has a rich flavour, good oil content and small seed. Mid season. B Type.
Avocado	Shepard	Fruit Tree \$45.00	Small to medium pear-shaped fruit with thick green skin that peels easily. Excellent flavour, medium oil content, does not turn brown when cut. Spreading habit, high yielding. Early to mid season.

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
<b>Avocado</b>	Reed	Fruit Tree \$50.00	The largest avocado fruit, with a thin shell and pale golden yellow flesh, buttery and delicious. Some say it is the best tasting avocado. Type A.
<b>Bacopa monniera</b>	Brahmi	Fruit Tree \$6.00	Used in traditional Indian medicine for over 3000 years and recent studies suggest it may improve memory and learning. Eat fresh or dry and make tea. Very easy to grow; best in damp conditions.
<b>Bambaroo</b>	Mango	Fruit Tree \$40.00	A grafted dwarf form of Kensington Pride Mango, the most popular cultivated variety due to it's superior taste and stringless flesh.
<b>Bay Tree</b>	Laurus nobilis	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Aromatic evergreen tree, originating from the Mediterranean, whose leaves are used in savoury cooking. Can be pruned to create a formal look.
<b>Blueberry "Biloxi"</b>	Vaccinium spp.	Fruit Tree \$30.00	Low chill blueberry. Early ripening, a few weeks before other varieties. Often produces a second crop later in the season. Firm fruit of medium size.
<b>Blueberry "Climax"</b>	Vaccinium ashei	Fruit Tree \$30.00	An early season Rabbiteye variety. Lower chill requirement. Performs better than other varieties in difficult soil. Very good flavour. Popular commercial variety. Likes acidic soil, so either grow in a pot with Azalea/Camellia mix, or dig peat moss into planting bed.
<b>Capsicum annum</b>	Jalapeno Chilli	Fruit Tree \$5.50	Heat 5/10. Bright red oval shaped fruit borne on a bush to 1m tall. Called chipotle chillies when dried.
<b>Capsicum annum</b>	Serrano Chilli	Fruit Tree \$5.50	A very popular chilli in Mexican cuisine. Plant grows up to 1.5m tall, bearing medium sized cylindrical green to red chillis. Typically eaten raw. Heat 6/10.
<b>Carica papaya</b>	Red Papaya Seedling	Fruit Tree \$10.00	A small palm shaped tree bearing large delicious red fleshed fruit. It's best to plant a few to ensure pollination, as papaya trees can be female, male or bisexual. Likes a sunny spot, sheltered from wind.
<b>Carob</b>	Carob siliqua	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Medium sized bushy, spreading tree, grown for it's long brown pods, the beans inside of which are used in making chocolate substitutes. Drought tolerant. Nitrogen fixing.

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
<b>Cocoa</b>	Cocoa (Theobroma cacao)	Fruit Tree \$20.00	The "Chocolate Tree". Small evergreen tree that requires a humid climate with high rainfall, year-round warmth and protection from strong winds. It is an understory tree, growing best with some dappled shade.
<b>Coffee plant</b>	Coffea arabica	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Attractive, glossy leaved shrub to around 2m tall. Grow in full sun to semi-shade. Fragrant white flowers are followed by bright red berries, which each contain two coffee beans.
<b>Curry Leaf Tree</b>	Murraya koenigii	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Attractive shrub native to India, whose leaves are used to add flavour to curry (fry with the onions). Can be invasive, so it's best to keep in a pot.
<b>Dream Herb</b>	Calea zacatechichi	Fruit Tree \$6.00	This herb is traditionally used by the Chontal Natives of Oaxaca Mexico for enhancing dreams. Very easy to grow and tolerant of neglect. Search the internet for more information on it's use.
<b>Drumstick Tree</b>	Moringa oleifera	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Fast growing tree to 10m tall, which produces edible leaves, pods, seeds and roots. Leaves can be eaten raw or cooked and are particularly nutritious and high in protein.
<b>Fruit Salad Plant</b>	Monstera deliciosa	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Climbing or scrambling epiphyte with very attractive tropical foliage and an edible fruit. Often used as an indoor plant.
<b>Grape</b>	Menindee Seedless	Fruit Tree \$35.00	The best green variety for eating fresh. Produces best in hot, dry areas. Requires a trellis or fence to grow on. Fruit needs to be picked ripe.
<b>Grapefruit</b>	Rio Red	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Has less colour than Star Ruby and the colour of fruit on individual trees can vary. Needs to be harvested soon after maturity.
<b>Grapefruit</b>	Star Ruby	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Medium sized seedless fruit, smooth thin peel with dark red flesh, excellent quality. Harder to grow than other varieties. Early season.
<b>Hibiscus sabdariffa</b>	Rosella	Fruit Tree \$3.50	Fast growing shrub to 2m which bears masses of fleshy red flower calyces which are used to make jam and tea. Originating from Africa.

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
Hog Plum	Spondias cytherea	Fruit Tree \$20.00	Large, fast growing tree bearing oval shaped green to yellow fruit. Fruit is eaten raw, stewed or used to make jam. Unripe fruit is used in curries and pickles. Fruit is also fed to pigs (hence the name!) in it's native Polynesia.
Ipomoea aquatica	Kang Kong	Fruit Tree \$6.00	An Asian vegetable, used in stir fries or as you would use ordinary spinach in cooking. Grows very easily in moist soil or in water.
Kaffir Lime	Citrus hystrix	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Attractive small tree with glossy green rounded double leaves which are used in Thai cooking. Full sun.
Kohala	Longan	Fruit Tree \$40.00	Small tree bearing large brown skinned fruit with white aromatic sweet jelly-like flesh. Related to Lychee but more vigorous.
Kumquat	Marumi Variegated	Fruit Tree \$35.00	A highly ornamental cumquat with light green and pale yellow foliage. The dark orange fruit, which are rich in Vitamin C, can remain on the tree for a long time. They can be eaten fresh or used in jams and marmalades. Well suited to being kept as a pot specimen.
Lemon	Eureka	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Probably the most widely grown lemon in the world. It's a true lemon with high juice and acid content. Thin-skinned and virtually seedless.
Lemon	Lisbon	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Smooth skinned, large, juicy bitter lemon produced on a thorny tree. Most of the year.
Lemon Grass	Cymbopogon citratus	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Clumping grass to 1.5m tall with strongly lemon scented stems and leaves, used in Asian cooking, teas and sweets. Very easy to grow. Full sun to part shade.
Lime	Tahiti	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Small to medium fruit, pale yellow, smooth skin. Translucent pale green flesh, tender and juicy with a true acid lime flavour. Best to pick fruit green as it can suffer from rot if left to ripen on the tree. Fruits more than once a year.
Longan	Chompoo	Fruit Tree \$40.00	Closely related to lychees, but with a light yellowy brown skin instead of pink. This Thai variety bears large, good quality fruit with pink tinged flesh. Faster and easier to grow than Lychee.

## Fruit Trees

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
Lychee	Bosworth No. 3	Fruit Tree \$40.00	Also known as Kwai Mai Pink. This very popular tree was brought to Australia from China in 1932. Small seeded, very sweet producing good crops every year. Mid season. Marcot cutting grown.
Mandarin	Emperor	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Large, very juicy fruit. Loose skinned with a good flavour. Fruits end of July, mid-late season.
Mandarin	Page	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Cross between a tangelo and a mandarin. Medium size fruit, easily peeled, deep orange flesh colour, juicy, seedless.
Mango	Nam Doc Mai	Fruit Tree \$40.00	Thai type mango. Green-yellow skin, sweet and juicy with an excellent flavour. This thin mango tree likes growing in coastal areas.
Mango	R2E2	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Mid-season variety with large, highly-coloured fruit. The second most popular mango variety grown. Mature fruit is beautifully yellow with a strong red blush and firm, non-fibrous flesh.
Manihot esculenta	Cassava	Fruit Tree \$12.00	A shrub with attractive leaves, whose tuberous roots are harvested and are boiled, fried, baked or made into flour. It is important to cook the roots thoroughly before eating. The refined starch from the tubers is called Tapioca.
Mentha piperata	Mint	Fruit Tree \$6.00	A spreading perennial herb which likes a moist position in part shade. Leaves used in desserts drinks, lollies and salads. Oh, and mojitos of course!
Miracle Berry	Synsepalum dulcificum	Fruit Tree \$15.00	A medium shrub with an edible berry; after it is eaten, sour foods taste sweet! Also said to counteract the metallic taste which is a side effect of chemotherapy. Slow growing. Likes a low pH. Does well in a pot.
Musa acuminata	Banana "Cavendish"	Fruit Tree \$25.00	A popular variety of banana that produces very sizeable bunches of large fruit. This is the most common variety in the supermarket. A tropical clumping plant growing up to 4m high. Plant in a sunny spot away from wind.
Naga Morich	Chilli	Fruit Tree \$5.50	An exceptionally hot chilli, similar to the "Ghost Chilli". One of the hottest know chillis in existence in fact! Traditionally used green in India, but can be used red as well. Meant to have an interesting smoky/ woody flavour profile, if you can get past the heat!

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
Navel Orange	Washington	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Main navel variety grown in Australia. Excellent skin colour and taste, round seedless fruit. Mid-season.
Orange	Late Valencia	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Large, oblong, firm fruit with a good flavour. Very juicy. Holds well on the tree. Late season.
Passiflora quadrangularis	Giant Granadilla	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Largest fruit in the passionfruit family. The fruit has white flesh which tastes like pear, and sweet acidic pulp in the middle. Requires a trellis.
Passionfruit	Panama	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Commercial passion fruit variety with purple fruit. Highly suited to tropical climate. Climber. Needs good drainage and full sun. Cutting grown.
Persicaria odorata	Vietnamese Coriander	Fruit Tree \$6.00	An intensely flavoured herb that is mainly used in Asian dishes, such as Laksa. Plants will grow best in warm, damp conditions.
Pineapple	Ananas comosus	Fruit Tree \$8.00	Pineapples are actually bromeliads! The familiar fruit grows on a short stalk in the middle of the spiky plant. Pick when already ripe - they don't ripen much after picking. Full sun.
Pummelo	Nam Roi	Fruit Tree \$35.00	Huge round fruit which have pale yellow flesh and taste like a sweet grapefruit. Nam Roi is a popular seedless variety, originating in Vietnam.
Queensland Nut	Macadamia integrifolia	Fruit Tree \$20.00	Produces the well known Macadamia nut. Bushy tree with shiny dark green leaves, growing up to 14m tall. Seed grown.
Seedless Valencia	Orange	Fruit Tree \$35.00	A seedless form of Valencia orange, with exceptional flavour. Fruits a little earlier, and is a heavy cropper. Plant in full sun. Grafted.
Star Apple	Chrysophyllum cainito	Fruit Tree \$25.00	Large, shady tree with attractive bronze undersides to the leaves. Bears round purple skinned fruit with juicy purple & white flesh. Best eaten fresh and chilled.

Fruit	Variety	Size/Price	Description
<b>Sweet Dragon Bamboo</b>	Dendrocalamus brandisii	Fruit Tree \$15.00	A tall clumping (not spreading) bamboo that produces thick upright stems which are excellent for building, due to their size and strength. Height to 25m. New shoots are edible. Does best in a well drained but moist location.
<b>Sweet Leaf</b>	Sauropus androgynus	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Tropical shrub whose tender leaves taste like fresh peas - beautiful! Use in salads or anywhere you would use spinach. Height to 2.5m. Full sun or part shade.
<b>Tamarillo</b>	Solanum betaceum	Fruit Tree \$10.00	Medium shrub in the tomato family, bearing clusters of red egg-shaped fruit with orange flesh, tasting a bit like a mix of passionfruit and tomato (it's nicer than it sounds!). Can be eaten fresh, stewed or used in desserts.
<b>Tangelo</b>	Citrus x. tangelo	Fruit Tree \$35.00	The tangelo is a citrus hybrid between tangerine and grapefruit. The fruits are the size of an adult fist and have a tangerine taste, but are very juicy and have loose skin.
<b>Tea Plant</b>	Camelia sinensis	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Evergreen shrub or small tree trimmed to below 2m when cultivated for its leaves. Flowers yellow-white. Mainly cultivated in subtropical and tropical areas. Grow in rich and moist soil.
<b>Thymus citriodorus</b>	Lemon Thyme	Fruit Tree \$5.50	A sprawling herb with tiny leaves used in savoury cooking, in salads and in herbal teas. Also used for it's aromatic properties. Grow in sun or part shade.
<b>Tumeric</b>	Curcuma longa	Fruit Tree \$12.00	Attractive tropical plant that is grown for it's bright orange roots, used as a spice in curries etc. Also consumed as a health tonic. Dies down in Winter, but sprouts back fresh when weather warms up.
<b>Wampi</b>	Clausena lansium	Fruit Tree \$15.00	Tropical fruit tree that bears clusters of yellow pleasantly aromatic fruit, similar in form to a grape. Evergreen tree growing 3-8m tall.
